## Thomas T Thomas 2018 Buster's Hill Pinot Noir (Anderson Valley) *Cellar Selection*

Earthy, savory, forest-floor aromas meet vivid black-cherry and rhubarb flavors in this medium-to full-bodied wine. It shows an herbal rosemary-and-black-pepper complexity that enhances the focused fruits. Light tannins give it structure for mid-term aging. Best from 2024. 94 pts/\$85 - JIM GORDON

## Thomas T Thomas 2018 Reserve Pinot Noir (Anderson Valley)

Complexity, depth and good structure make this medium- to full-bodied wine something to savor. It offers woodsy, mushroomy, forest-floor aromas and a moderately tannic palate that is layered with memorable black cherry, sour cherry, black tea and dried herbs. 94 pts/\$80 - JIM GORDON

## **Thomas T Thomas 2018 Estate Grown Pinot Noir (Anderson Valley)**

A roasted fruit complexity and mouthfilling texture highlight this full-bodied, smooth-textured wine. Abundant red and black cherry on the palate are shaded by hints of tobacco and rosemary while moderate tannins add grip. Best from 2024. 92 pts/\$65 - <u>JIM GORDON</u>

## **Thomas T Thomas 2018 T Pinot Noir (Anderson Valley)**

Vivid raspberry and red-cherry flavors come together on a firm but polished texture in this elegant and harmonious wine. The fruit flavors are concentrated and lingering, while the mouthfeel is full but lively. 93 pts/\$45 - <u>JIM GORDON</u>
